


### Description

This N-Channel enhancement mode power MOSFET is produced using Fairchild Semiconductor's proprietary planar stripe and DMOS technology. This advanced MOSFET technology has been especially tailored to reduce on-state resistance, and to provide superior switching performance and high avalanche energy strength. These devices are suitable for switched mode power supplies, active power factor correction (PFC), and electronic lamp ballasts.




Figure 1. On-Region Characteristics




Figure 2. Transfer Characteristics




Figure 3. On-Resistance Variation vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




Figure 4. Body Diode Forward Voltage Variation vs. Source Current and Temperature




Figure 5. Capacitance Characteristics




Figure 6. Gate Charge Characteristics




Figure 7. Breakdown Voltage Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 8. On-Resistance Variation vs. Temperature




Figure 9. Maximum Safe Operating Area




Figure 10. Maximum Drain Current vs. Case Temperature




Figure 11. Transient Thermal Response Curve




Figure 12. Gate Charge Test Circuit & Waveform




Figure 13. Resistive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms




Figure 14. Unclamped Inductive Switching Test Circuit & Waveforms




Figure 15. Peak Diode Recovery dv/dt Test Circuit & Waveforms




Figure 16. TO220, Molded, 3-Lead, Jedec Variation AB


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
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
